

INFORMATION - SELLING YOUR GOODS AT TENDER DISPOSALS

1. Bring your goods to us on any day between 9am & 4pm except Monday.
2. Complete and sign an Instruction to Sell Form – listing your goods and clarifying their legal ownership – photo I.D. required (i.e. drivers licence)
3. Reserve Price – this should be the lowest price you are willing to accept rather than what you are `hoping to get`. We will do our best to sell it for the highest price possible. You should be aware that we have a totally automated & computerized selling system.
4. This reserve price will apply for three sales – after that you must collect the goods or if you choose to leave them in the sale the reserve price nominated will be decreased by 10% for each sale until sold or collected.
5. Goods should be in clean, working condition. All electrical items must be tested and certified as safe by an electrician. We can have this done for you at a cost of \$5 payable on booking in.
6. Smaller items of a value of \$20 or less will be offered at 'NO RESERVE' and sold on the spot or the highest offer.
7. Like items such as C.D.'s should be taped together – saleable lots of 10 would be suitable for CD's.
8. ALL GOODS ARE STORED AT YOUR RISK – insurance is the owner's responsibility.
9. Goods that in the opinion of Tender Disposals require cleaning or assembly will be subject to \$15 fee.
10. Goods, which are dirty, stained or unsaleable, will not be accepted. Flammable liquids not accepted.
11. Government regulation prevents us from selling such goods as firearms, dangerous consumers items pornographic material etc. Full list is available form reception.
12. Results are available form our website www.tenderdisposals.com have your sellers form handy. If you see tenders on goods you would like to accept, please call reception 3290 5300 to accept these offers.
13. If we determine that your goods are unsaleable we will send you a collection notice. Failing to comply with this within 7 days will result in goods being disposed of at the discretion of Tender Disposals.
14. It is the responsibility of the seller to check the status of their goods -goods uncollected after 3 months will be deemed abandoned and may be disposed of at the discretion of Tender Disposals.

PAYMENT

1. Cheques are made payable to the named seller on the Instructions to Sell Form.
2. Payment is normally ready for collection by cheque on the following Sale Weekend after we have received payment from the buyer.
